

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
OF THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF SAUKVILLE, OZAUKEE COUNTY  
November 26, 2002**

**Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, November 26, 2002, immediately following completion of the Public Hearing on the proposed 2003 budget, which begins at 7:00 p.m. at the Saukville Town Hall, a special town meeting of the electors is called pursuant to Section 60.12(1)(c) of Wisconsin Statutes by the town board for the following purposes:**

- 1. To adopt the 2002 tax levy to be paid in 2003 pursuant to Section 60.10(1)(a) of Wisconsin Statutes.**
- 2. To establish compensation for the elected position of Constable to be effective with the term commencing in April 2003 pursuant to Section 60.32 of Wisconsin Statutes.**

**Further notice is given that a special Town of Saukville board meeting will be convened immediately following the special town meeting for the purpose of approving the 2003 budget.**

After Clerk Clarke presented the 2003 proposed budget at the public hearing, Chairman Hoffman convened the special town meeting of electors.

A general discussion of the merits of increasing the constable's salary from \$300 annually to \$1000 annually ensued.

Elector Larry Beverung moved to adopt the proposed budget's 2002 tax levy of \$147,000 to be paid in 2003; elector Jim Adams seconded; motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

After additional discussion, Supervisor Niehaus moved to raise the Constable's salary to \$1000 annually to reflect increasing responsibilities and workload; Chairman Hoffman seconded; motion carried by voice vote.

Elector Beverung then began a discussion of the Chairman and Supervisors salaries as compared with neighboring communities. After citing a report listing salaries from these communities, he proposed raising the salary of the Chairman by \$1,000 to \$5,000 annually and then proposed raising the salary of the Supervisors by \$1,000 to \$3000. Jim Adams moved to approve raising each board members salary by \$1000 annually; Ginny Pierson seconded; motion carried by voice vote.

Absent: Supervisor Wollmer


**2. Pledge of Allegiance**
